

Suggested Outline for a *How to Hear God's Voice* DVD/CD Class with a Small Group

Important Notes

1. The order of the keys is not crucial, as it is easier to teach them in a different order than is found in Habakkuk 2:1, 2. The essential thing is to use all four keys at the same time.
2. Be sure that each person in attendance has a Seminar Workbook for use while watching the DVDs. We strongly recommend that each person or family also have a *How to Hear God's Voice Interactive Manual* and do the assigned work between classes.
3. The Teacher's Guide is not designed to go along with the DVD series. It is for those teaching the course themselves with the *Interactive Manual*.
4. You, as the group leader, should prepare yourself by going through the course and integrating the skills to be taught.
 - b. Watch one DVD (generally around 60 minutes), and have participants take notes in the appropriate sections of the "How to Hear God's Voice Seminar Workbook."
 - c. Have a journaling time as instructed on the DVD (about 7 minutes).
 - i. Have people share their journaling in groups of 2 (about 5 minutes).
 - ii. Have 3-6 people volunteer to read their journaling to the entire group (about 8 – 10 minutes).
 - d. Have an interactive discussion about:
 - i. what they watched on the DVD;
 - ii. the journaling received and/or shared;
 - iii. assigned reading they have done from the last week;
 - iv. issues they are encountering as they have tried to integrate the skills being learned.
 - e. Assign the required reading for the following week.
 - f. Close with a prayer (and perhaps song)
 - i. of thanksgiving
 - ii. prayer to meet people's specific needs.

In each weekly group session you will spend about 90 – 120 minutes completing the following:

- a. Open with fellowship/song and prayer inviting the Holy Spirit's presence.
